DISTRICT OUIZ

Purpose:

To encourage inter-Club socialising amongst Lions Clubs throughout District 105A.

Aims:

To run a Quiz competition within District 105A. Aimed at encouraging friendship and good fellowship between Lions Clubs of District 105A with a little bit of competitiveness.

Period:

Individual Zone competition - Shall be completed by date confirmed by Competitions Officer.

District final - Shall be held late January/ early February, venue and date will be confirmed by the District Competitions Officer.

Criteria:

- a. Each club is entitled to enter just one team into the competition.
- b. A team shall consist of a minimum 3 or maximum 4 Club Lions in both Zone and District final.
- c. Each Zone Chairperson is responsible for booking the venue and date of his/her Zone competition. The District Competitions Officer shall provide a set of questions and answers.
- d. Any club may also enter a fun team (of any size) in the Zone competition. They cannot however progress to the District final
- e. The winners and 2nd place teams shall progress to the District final.
- f. The District Competitions Officer is responsible for booking the venue and date of the District final and shall provide a set of questions and answers.
- g. Both the Zone competition & District final shall comprise of 10 rounds of questions.
- n. Each team will have a Joker which doubles their score of any one round. If a team thinks that it has done well in a round, it may wish to play its Joker. This must be played before the answers are given and the sheet is marked.
- i. The winner of the District final will receive the District Trophy.
