DISTRICT 105A QUIZ COMPETITION - RULES

- 1 Each Club in the District will be entitled to enter one team for the competition
- A Team will consist of three (minimum) or four (maximum) Lions a team need not be made up by the same members for each heat
- The "Zone Heat" will be teams from within a Zone. The Zone Chairman to be responsible for booking the date and venue & advising the Clubs in his Zone.
- The District Competitions Officer will supervise (where possible) and run each quiz assisted by two Zone Chairmen (and the Region Chairman if appointed that year), plus any additional help which may be required on the night
- The quiz consists of ten rounds with ten questions in each round. Usually, the questions require a one or two word answer which must be clearly written on the question paper. Time allowed per round: 5 mins. Some answers are more than two words.
- Each correct answer will be awarded one point. The answer and decision of the District Competitions Officer (or his deputy) will be final.
- Before a round starts a team may opt to play their 'Joker' by noting 'J' at top of that paper. Score will be doubled for that round; only one 'J' allowed per team
- 8 The three top teams of the Zone heat will go forward to the Region Heat.
- 9 If scores are equal, i.e. a tie, further questions will be asked only of those teams in contention until three teams are left
- The Region Heat will be run along similar lines as above, but only the winning team will go forward to the District Final
- The Region Heat venue and date will be arranged by the Region Chairman. The two Zone Chairmen and the Region Chairman will assist the District Competitions Officer (or deputy) to run the Quiz as in the Zone Heats
- The Zone heat must be completed by 30th September and the Region Heat by the 30th November.

DISTRICT FINAL will be played in FEBRUARY. This is to allow the trophy to be presented to the winning Club at the District Convention at the beginning of March.
