

RULES FOR THE LCIF TROPHY  
(and International Relations)

Points are awarded to Clubs who supports the most projects under LCIF, not necessarily the most money raised, or for the greatest number of Melvin Jones Fellowships received by it's members.

Undesignated donations

- Melvin Jones Fellowships (US\$1,000)
- Club Plaque (US\$1,000)
- Contributing Membership (US\$20 per member)

Designated donations

- Hospitals, Hospices, Schools etc.
- Eye Camps (via LCIF)
- Water wells (via LCIF)
- Emergency donations (via LCIF)
- Special Humanitarian Appeals

International support

- Malawi student (£100 per student)
- Water wells (via WaterAid)
- Eye Camps (via British Royal Commonwealth Institute for the Blind - Sight Savers (Haywards Heath))
- Spectacles collected
- Clothes collected
- Special Humanitarian Appeals (Bosnia, etc) via other Districts, other agencies, eg Red Cross, Save the Children Fund, etc

Results judged on information obtained from District Officers' reports and from M&A reports, so don't forget to include all relevant information.
